RE: COVID-19 Safety Advisory for All Common Carriers

Effective May 29, 2021, Governor Baker is lifting certain COVID restrictions, but maintaining a face mask requirement in some situations:

Occupancy Limits Common Carriers are NO longer required to limit the occupancy of their

vehicles. Vehicle occupancy is the limit set by the manufacturer.

**Face Coverings** Face coverings **remain mandatory** for all individuals on public and

private transportation systems, including rideshares, livery, taxi, ferries,

MBTA, Commuter Rail and transportation stations.
